The **Ice Breaker Clever Catch®** provides an excellent way for children to get to know each other and feel more comfortable in a large group. Students answer a series of questions about themselves and the things that matter to them at their appropriate age level. There are 72 questions included. Clever Catch® Ice Breaker can be used at school in organized classroom activities. It can also be used on the playground or at home. Grades 4+, Ages 9+.

BASIC PLAY:

Basic play for Clever Catch® is simple. Two or more players toss the ball to each other, answering the question under, or closest to, their left thumb. Each problem is numbered and enclosed in its own space, assuring the child will know which question to answer. Most questions are open-ended, allowing players to elaborate if they feel comfortable doing so.

Have the students (and teacher) stand and make one large circle either in the classroom or somewhere with enough open space. Have the students toss the Ice Breaker ball back and forth to each other while answering the questions found underneath or closest to their left thumb.

To ensure that every student gets a chance to share with the class, have them sit down after they have had a turn. After everyone is sitting, stand up and start again! This is a great way for students and teachers to learn something new and interesting about each other.
